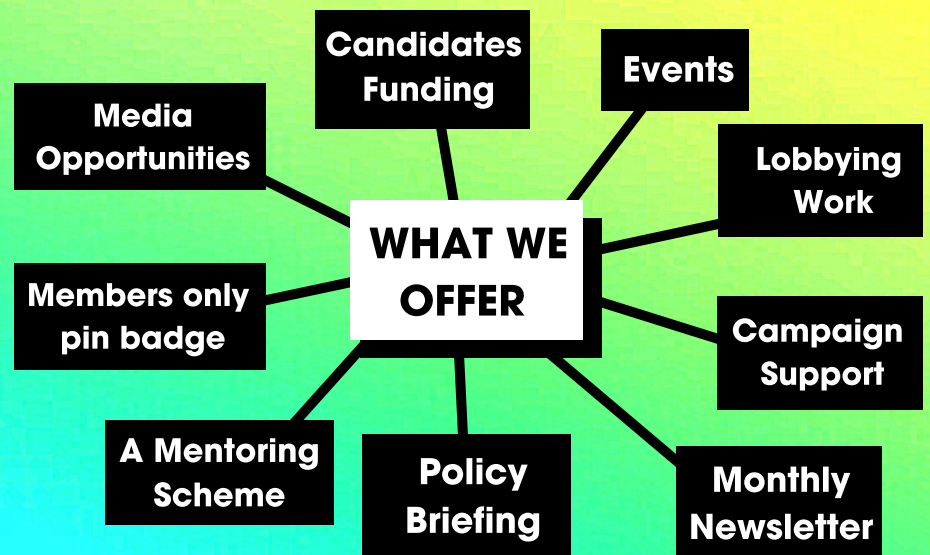


Who we are
